Mr. Richardson has been the Director of the Long Beach District Office, U.S. Dept. of Labor, OWCP, Longshore & Harbor Workers' Compensation Programs, since June, 2000. Prior to this, Mr. Richardson spent 7 years as a Claims Examiner and Senior Claims Examiner at the OWCP District Office in Seattle, and 2 years as Manager of the Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program, at FEMA Region 10. He co-founded the OWCP's first mediation program in 1996.

Originally from Santa Rosa, California, Mr. Richardson attended the University of Washington on an Army ROTC scholarship, receiving his Bachelors of Arts degree in Anthropology with honors in 1987. He served on active duty for four years in the Army's Medical Service Corps at Fort Sam Houston and Fort Hood, Texas, after which he transferred to the Army Reserve. His career in the Army Reserve includes various command and staff positions, to include Operations Officer of the Medical 'Falcon' Task Force during an 8-month rotation to Kosovo in 2003. His military education includes Command & General Staff College, and the Joint Medical Planner's Course. He retired at the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in 2007, last serving as Executive Officer of the 176th Medical Group in Garden Grove, CA.
